### Good News! Park Mark® can now be displayed on Traffic Signs for Car Parks!

As a result of the changes introduced through the review of the Traffic Signs and General Directions (TSRGD), Traffic Authorities will no longer need to apply to Government for a Special Authorisation in order to use the Park Mark® device on car park direction signs.

TSRGD (Amendment) Regulations 2011, which come into effect on 31 January 2012 prescribe a Park Mark® device for general use in Great Britain.
