NSL's eyes and ears to support local searches for a missing child



- > Through a company-wide initiative to encourage and harness ideas from staff members, NSL's frontline workers have been able to do more for their local communities
- > By submitting his idea to the My Contribution scheme, Paul Abbott, a Senior Civil Enforcement Officer, was able connect his company's frontline workers with Child Rescue Alert, a system that triggers an alert via SMS or email when a child has gone missing nearby
- > Recognising the importance of Child Rescue Alerts, Paul Abbott has played a central role in encouraging colleague's right across the UK to register for the alerts, with his efforts already resulting in a significant increase in the number of people registered

PUSH

- > Alarm is raised if a child is abducted and in imminent danger.
- > First few hours are crucial if the child is to be found safe.
- > Texts and emails are sent with a description / photo of the child.
- > New to the UK – but more than 800 children found so far in USA.
